# The 2006 Competitors

**Keith Linney** - The 2003 champion, Colorado Keith has the sweetest swing, and is the only player in tournament history to have climbed every damn mountain in Colorado.

**Dennis "Little Walter" Schrantz** - A fine harp player and Blues artist, but there are no trophies for that. It is too bad that he can't practice golf in months with "R"s in them.

**John White** - John possesses an all-around solid game, and is a definite threat to those wishing to win the Myrtle Beach Championship. If he avoids three-putts, he'll win.

**Al "Bogey-Pro" Green** - With his skilled chipping game, Al has strong chances of winning a trophy. Take this guy for granted and he'll sneak up and bite you in the ass.

**Jeff "Dr. Pud" Fitzgerald** - Long and strong, Pud would be the favorite except for his occasional OB shots. *Editor's Choice* if his putter gets hot and his driver stays home.

**Phil "Blues Man" Shirley** - The best picker in the group, Phil has added distance and consistency to his game, but a lack of serious practice will make winning difficult.

**Scott Yelton** - A 6'4", 180 pound triathlon athlete from Raleigh, Scott introduces a new level of fitness to the MB Championship. Look for other players to buff up next year.

**Erik Rasmussen** - Now living in Spain, where he never golfs, Erik won the MB Championship in 2004 and 2005. Hopefully the Handicap Committee was paying attention.

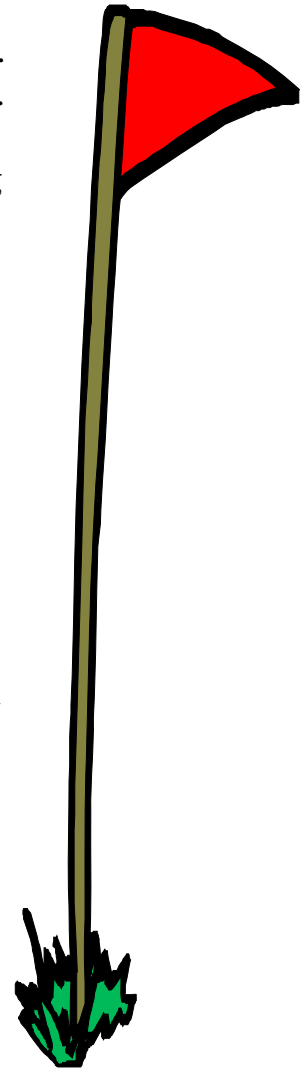
# Rules of Golf

## 2006 Myrtle Beach Championship

- 1) No mulligans.
- 2) If you were trying to hit it and you miss, that's a whiff, and it counts.
- 3) If this is for a 9, pick it up. It is good. Putt everything else. Absolutely no gimmes.
- 4) If a guy picks it up instead of putting it in the hole, that's a 9. I know it was only 2 inches, and I'm sorry, but maybe he won't do it again.
- 5) If you hit it where it might be OB or you might not find it, play a provisional from the same spot before you go looking.
- 6) Did you say the word "provisional"? You gotta say the word provisional. If you didn't say "provisional", the ball you just hit, including a 2-stroke penalty, is the only ball in play. If you find the first one, OB or not, pick it up and put it in your pocket.
- 7) If your ball stops in your own fairway, you may, at your option, mark your ball with a tee, pick up your ball, clean it, and place it within one club-length of its original position, no nearer the hole. That is called "Lift, Clean and Place" when the pros do it.
- 8) If your ball stops in the rough, or a hazard, or some other hole's fairway, don't even think about touching it (unless, of course, it is in standing water, or ground under repair, or an immovable man-made obstruction blocks your swing or ball's flight path).
- 9) When you replace your ball on the green after you mark it and clean it, try to place it within a millionth of an inch of its original location.
- 10) Play "ready golf". No fartin' around. If the guy with honors isn't ready to tee off, you do it. Get out of your cart and walk to your ball instead of waiting to be driven.
- 11) No "leaf rule". If you drive into the middle of the fairway or anywhere else, but can't find your ball after 5 minutes of looking, go back to the tee and hit another. You now lie 3.
- 12) No "building a tee" in the fairway. You can "place" your ball in the fairway, but no construction work.
- 13) No slow play. Be ready to hit when it is your turn. At the tee all 4 guys should get their clubs and stand on the tee while each tees off in sequence. Don't sit in the cart and wait until the other three have hit, and then start cleaning your club.
- 14) All decisions of The Committee are final. There is no appeal process. Get over it.

# Other Important Information

- 1) Thursday's practice round is the responsibility of individual competitors. Pay and play if you like, at any of Myrtle Beach's 100 plus courses. Or rest.
- 2) Our condos are at the Ocean Reef Resort, 7100 N. Ocean Blvd., Myrtle Beach, South Carolina - (888) 322-6411. Breakfast is on-site.
- 3) There will be a "pot luck" supper on Friday night in Condos 1 and 2. If your Condo group is attending, bring a covered dish or something.
- 4) Condo Captains are responsible for maintaining condo keys, making sure all players have arranged for a ride to the courses, "Most Incredible Shot" voting, and Sunday morning condo cleaning.
- 5) Trophies are provided for first place in the Championship Flight, and also the First, Second, and Third Flights.
- 6) Handicaps and Friday's first round pairings will be announced and posted Thursday at 9 pm in Condo #3.
- 7) Saturday's pairings will be posted at 6:00 pm Friday in Condo #1.
- 8) A special traveling trophy is awarded to the nominator of "The Most Incredible Shot". The person who actually shot the most incredible shot is given a golf ball. All nominations are made at Saturday night's Happy Hour at Condo #3, 5:30 Saturday. Condo Captains decide.
- 9) Prior to the final day of the tournament, all leader deficits are halved. Also, the Johnny Cochran rule is in effect ("If it's over 10, halve it again").
- 10) Adjustments, Flights, and final round pairings are revealed at 8:00 Saturday night in Condo #3.
- 11) All competitors are responsible for arranging their own transportation, including travel to and from Myrtle Beach, to and from the airport, travel to dinner, and travel to the courses all three days.
- 12) Plan on playing in the rain. If the course closes, or conditions are not fair, the Committee may shorten the tournament. If it rains hard, and we don't play, you better plan on doing well at the poker table.
